**Baptism**—act of obedience after salvation

## Scripture Memory 2009

### Guidelines:

1. The FAITH section must be done first.
2. The FOUNDATIONS FOR CHRISTIAN LIFE section is to be done second.
3. Three verses must be said at a time with only one help per verse.
4. 100 points will be given for each verse memorized and 1,000 bonus points will be given for every ten verses memorized.
5. 5,000 bonus points will be given for those that memorize the FAITH section; and an additional 10,000 bonus points will be given for those that memorize the FOUNDATIONS FOR CHRISTIAN LIFE section.
6. All those that memorize thirty verses or more will be entered into a drawing. Only one winner per week. One can only win one time per summer. No cash payouts.
7. The scoring committee reserves the right to deduct points when submitted after the deadline or when score sheets are unreadable or completed incorrectly.
8. In the event teams are uneven, the scoring system will be fairly adjusted.
9. 25,000 bonus points will be awarded to each individual who can say the whole FAITH section in one sitting with no more than 20 helps total.
10. The score sheet is due in the camp office by 2:00 p.m. on Friday.
